

Dear Taxpayer:

As your Assessor, it is my responsibility to ensure all citizens of Morgan County are being taxed fairly and equally.

Persons living in Morgan County with **OUT-OF-STATE LICENSE PLATES** for more than 30 days, violate **WV State Code §17-A-3-1a. Registration of vehicles of new residents.** Which, in part states... Every owner of a motor vehicle, trailer or other vehicle, shall, **within thirty (30) days after taking up residence in the state**, apply to the division and obtain registration and title for the vehicle.

It is illegal for residents who have **OUT-OF-STATE LICENSE PLATES**. It is also unfair to the citizens of Morgan County who pay their personal property taxes annually.

I would like to ask for your help, by reporting those who are violating WV State Code §17-A-3-1a. If you discover a vehicle with **OUT-OF-STATE LICENSE PLATES**, which have been in the county for **more than 30 days**, please answer the questions below.
